

BIBLE TIC-TAC-TOE

All ages – use easier Bible Questions for younger children and more difficult ones with older children.

Print off a Bible Tic-tac- toe card for each player. The sheets can be a full 8 ½ X 11 sheet or it can be ½ of a sheet. Use card stock or heavy paper so it can be used over again.

If you want you can allow each child to make their own card from a piece of cardboard or grocery sack. This can be a fun at home activity. It can count as art if you home school. Decide what size and let the child measure using a ruler and draw off a board. Then let the children that are old enough to use scissors cut out their board. They can then decorate it with stickers, crayons, or maybe some old Bible class materials that have pictures of the subject matter. You may even want to add a memory verse. Do as much or as little as time and supplies permits.

There are three sets of questions available listed here on different Bible characters and lessons. You can create your own on other lessons you may want to do with your children. If you use large colorful buttons as markers the page can be used over and over again. If you have boys you may want to use large clean bolts, washers or nuts for the markers. Whatever works for you and your family is fine. You can just use a piece of plain paper and crayons to mark the X's and O's if you choose.

If you children are old enough to read you may want to make it fun by writing each question on separate pieces of paper. Fold the pieces and put into a basket, bowl, hat or whatever. Let them take turns drawing out the questions to read and who ever answers correctly can place a marker on the board. If you are busy you may want them to do the reading and you can still play as they place the markers for you. Or if you have several children you may want to divide up into teams and take turns answering. Make it a fun learning experience for all of you. Just follow the regular rules for tic-tac-toe except they only get to place a marker as they can answer the questions.
