

Dear parent,

Below is a 'worship sheet' that may be used by your children during worship hour to help them participate in worship. It is often difficult for young children to sit still and pay attention for a whole hour. With this sheet they listen for the names of Bible characters used in the sermon & write down the page # of the songs that were sung. There are also 4 lines across the page for you to write words that will be in the lesson. They listen for those words and make a mark under the word to keep up with how many times the preacher says the word in his lesson. Then after worship you can help them write a sentence or two of what lesson they might have learned from the sermon. Maybe you can answer any questions they have about what was taught.

There are 2 forms below. The first one is for young writers – the second one is for children that can learn more and write faster. Please use the sheets in a positive way to encourage your children to learn to enjoy worshipping the LORD. If necessary you can make adjustments to the sheets that best fit the needs of your child.
