

Instructions for DAVID bulletin board

Bulletin Board: DAVID

A simple way to make a bulletin board is just to use the name of the Bible character you are teaching. Make each letter as large as it can fit onto a colored piece of poster board. You can make a transparency of each letter and use the overhead projector. Be sure your letters are all about the same size. Then draw pictures on them to represent each of the areas of that character's life. See the one done for DAVID below: also 'DAVID bulletin board' in list below for full sheet size letters (11 x 8 ½) that may be printed off for your use. The pictures came from some clip art I had available.

This works well for the teacher with a board or just a space on the wall. If you choose you can cut out pictures that are extras from old Bible class materials and glue onto the letters. I like to put my letters on colored poster board, a different color for each letter. If you are drawing a picture that needs to be colored you may choose to use white poster board.

Another option is to make the letters ¼ the size of the poster board (or whatever size works for you) then place the letters onto the board in the center and put the pictures for the different areas of the characters life around the name. What other ideas can you come up with to change this idea?
