

GOD gives a law **Key**

Exodus 19 – 20

“I am the LORD thy GOD, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage . Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.”
Exodus 20:2-3

8- (Joshua – **Aaron**) fashioned a golden calf from the people’s jewelry.

9- (Moses – **GOD**) wrote the commandments on the tablets of stone.

10- Moses made the people (**drink** – bathe in) the water with the ground-up calf in it.

11- Israel made a (**covenant** – secret) with GOD to keep His law.
