

## **“I Want To Teach”**

### **Lesson 8, Bible Learning Activity:**

The goal in all Bible classes should be to learn GOD’s Word. After we have presented the lesson, whether it is an event in Bible times or a subject like kindness, we must re-enforce the things learned so the information will remain in our student’s memory. There are many ways this can be done – these ways are what I refer to as Bible learning activities.

This is an activity the students participate in during the review session. It may be used on Sunday morning as well as Wednesday night. If your activity is a game it can be used over and over again. This is usually a longer and more involved activity than the Readiness Activity. It should be applicable to the factual part of the lesson or the lesson aims. This could be in the form of activity sheets, games, art, etc. This activity is to be a learning activity. It should be interesting and easily understood. This is not a “just for fun” only activity. If we make the activity challenging and interesting the students will enjoy it! Be sure to remember the goal is to teach GOD’s word, not just to entertain. Learning GOD’s Word can be fun! Excitement is infectious – when the teacher shows excitement about the activities in class the students will also be excited.
