

Thanks to Dorothy for these great household tips!

1. **To reheat pizza:** using a nonstick skillet on top of the stove, set heat to med-low and heat until warm. This keeps the crust crispy. (It also works to use a cast iron skillet and lightly spray with Pam then heat pizza, tkg)
2. **Easy deviled eggs:** Put the egg yolks in a zip lock bag, seal, then mash until they are all broken up. Add remainder of ingredients, reseal bag, mash until it is thoroughly mixed. Cut the tip of a bottom corner of the bag; squeeze the yolk mixture into the egg whites. Clean up is simply – just throw away the bag!
3. **Expanding frosting:** Purchase a container of your favorite frosting, whip it with your mixer a few minutes. You can double it in size. More frosting, less sugar and calories per serving.
4. **Reheat refrigerated bread:** For biscuits, pancakes or muffins that were refrigerated; place in microwave with a cup of water. The increased moisture will keep the food moist and reheat more quickly.
5. **Newspaper weeds away:** As you work the nutrients in your soil, wet news paper and put layers around the plants overlapping as you go; cover with mulch and forget the weeds.
6. **Clean up broken glass:** Use a wet cotton ball or Q-tip to pick up the small shards of glass you cannot easily see.
7. **Squirrel away:** Sprinkle your plants with cayenne pepper. The pepper does not hurt the plants and the squirrels do not like the pepper.
8. **Easy measuring:** Fill your measuring cup with hot water before using for sticky substances (peanut butter, etc.), dump out the water, do not dry out the cup, then measure your substances. It comes right out.
9. **Defog windshield:** Buy a chalkboard eraser and keep in the car, swipe foggy windows with the eraser.
10. **Get rid of ants:** Put small piles of cornmeal where you see ants. They eat it and take it home, but they cannot digest it so it kills them. It may take a week or two, but Dorothy says it works.
